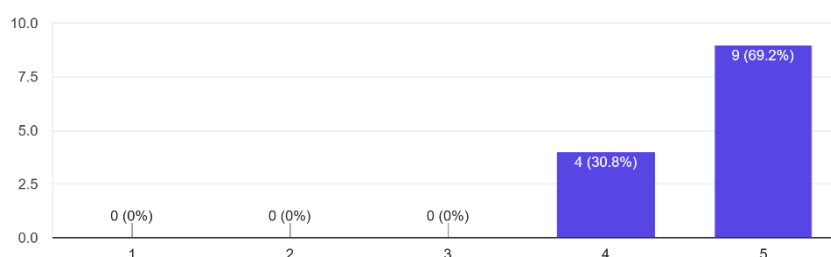
#### Analysis of responses

##### 1. Relevance of the webinar

The feedback indicates an overall their satisfaction regarding the usefulness and relevance of the webinar. Most participants strongly agreed that the webinar had clear objectives and learning outcomes, meaning that the webinar was well received and highly effective. 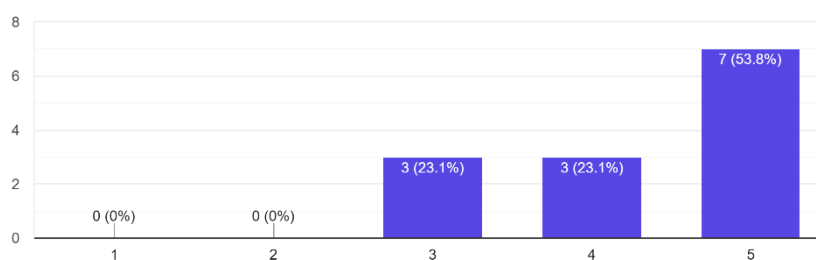
The webinar had clear objectives and learning outcomes.

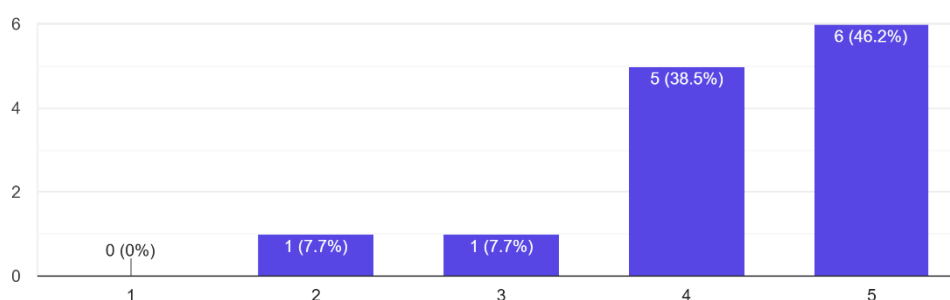


## 2. Delivery of the workshop

Concerning the delivery of the workshop, the results show that participants generally found it clear and appropriate to their needs. However, two participants gave ratings below 4, meaning that improvements can be considered for the second workshop. Even though the low ratings are few, there may still be opportunities to better address the needs of all participants. This same observation applies as well to the usefulness of the workshop in improving participants' online teaching practices.

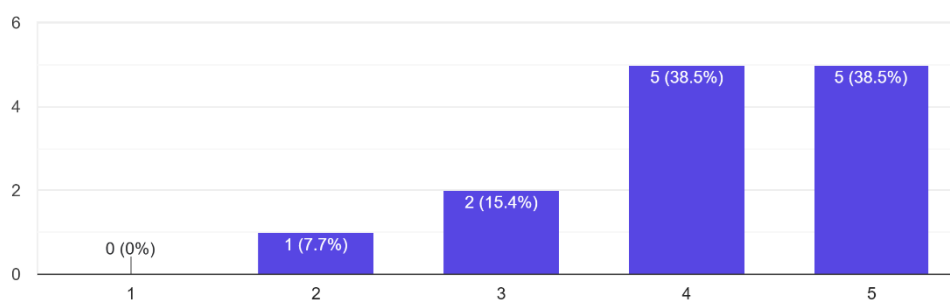
The delivery of the workshop was clear and appropriate to participants' needs.

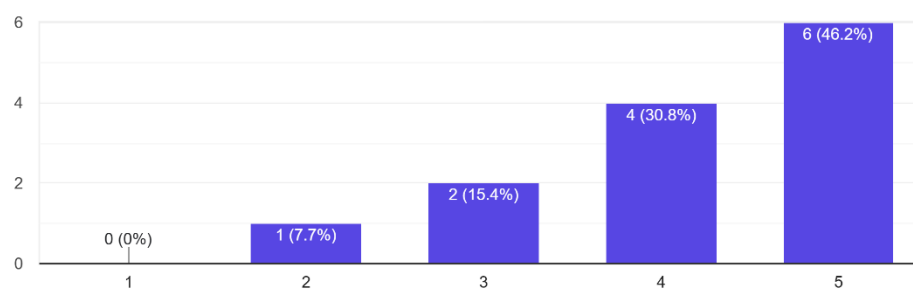
How useful do you find the workshop for improving online teaching practices?
